LITM provides a forum for candid discussions, a safe environment for differing perspectives, and the opportunity to explore complex issues and solutions. Participating alumni will reconnect with fellow classmates, build relationships with community leaders, step into new opportunities, turn emotion into action, and ultimately drive civic engagement for the betterment of Gwinnett County.
