COVID-19 Preparedness Plan (effective June 2022)

Because the health, safety and well-being of our classes, volunteers and staff is at the forefront of everything we do, we are taking every precaution we can to provide a safe environment for you. While we are fully engaged to offer in person learning for the Class of 2023, we are aware that the COVID-19 situation is continuing to evolve. Should guidance from the CDC and our local health department change, we are ready to make necessary changes to abide by the revised guidelines, including rescheduling, cancelling, or shifting events to virtual platforms.

The goal of this plan is to mitigate the potential for transmission of COVID-19 for participants in this program. This requires the full cooperation of participants, volunteers, presenters & staff. Only through a cooperative effort can we maintain the safety and health of those involved. Participants, volunteers, presenters & staff are responsible for implementing and complying with all aspects of this plan.

In Person Expectations *

- Attendance is crucial to your LG experience, however if you learn you have been exposed to COVID, are experiencing symptoms, awaiting test results, and/or receive a positive test result, please do not attend the Leadership Gwinnett activity, and contact the LG Director, Programs immediately.
 - Participants may be screened for COVID-19 symptoms upon arrival for in person sessions. <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html>. Individuals who report symptoms at screening will be asked to leave.
- Participants, volunteers, presenters & staff will follow facility guidelines as provided by locations we visit in person. Any specifics we encounter will be communicated in advance of the in-person sessions.
- Participants, volunteers, presenters & staff will have access to masks and hand sanitizer provided by program host sites or Leadership Gwinnett.

Program Dates throughout 2022-23 *

- Program dates listed with your acceptance email are set and will likely be in-person with virtual elements dependent on current local COVID- 19 data.
- The Fall Retreat scheduled for September 16-18. 2022 will require two nights of lodging for an in-person experience. The tuition you pay allows for double occupancy at hotel.

For two nights the Fall retreat, there will be an accommodation charge of \$300 for a single room and no extra charge if you are comfortable with a roommate. For one night at the Spring retreat in May, there will be an accommodation charge of \$150 for a single room and no extra charge if you are comfortable with a roommate.
