- Engage support of colleagues and family
- Set aside plenty of time multiple "sittings"
- Understand the technical aspects of completing the application
- Read through the entire application first
- Complete each section fully
- Leverage your strengths
- o Ensure the product is the best representation of you to a selection team

• Application Components

- Demographic Information
- o Tuition, Funding, Prior Program Engagement, and Application Fee
 - Tuition is \$3,750, due July 12, 2023
 - Partial scholarships available. Click here for the scholarship application.
 - Be sure to include all leadership programs you've participated in (community, job specific, etc.)
 - \$25 application fee. Click here to pay online.
- o Commitment to 100% attendance and full engagement in the experience
 - Be sure to include your signature on the attendance portion of the application.
 - You will need to obtain your supervisor's signature of approval for the program dates either on the main application or via an online form (whichever you prefer). <u>Click here</u> to access the online form.
- o Community & Civic Involvement
 - Go beyond what you are already doing for your job
 - Ex: an initiative that you helped get off the ground
- Education & Other Achievements
 - Degrees
 - Industry certification
 - Advanced credits
 - Leadership development programs
- o Employment Experience
 - Take time to brag on yourself and share your employment accomplishments
- Commitment
 - Don't feel like you are restricted to three lines
 - Give the reviewer a lot of meat to go on
- Community Awareness
 - "Essay" part of application
 - Write one paragraph for each issue identified
